Although, not everyone thinks positively of Christians...

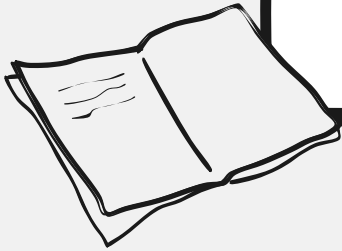

I can't explain it, but I suddenly had this extra patience and love for everyone I met and felt so close to Jesus cos I was seeing Him all over the place!

I **challenge** you to **re:**calibrate your focus to look for Jesus in everyone you lay eyes on and see how the world looks through this lens.

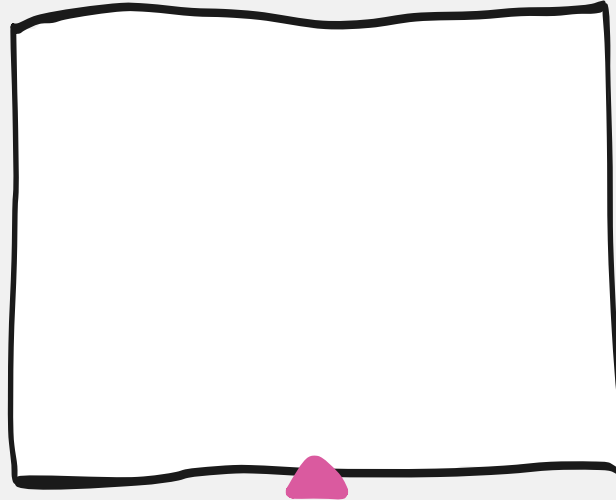
Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

On their own, these lines are just sticks.

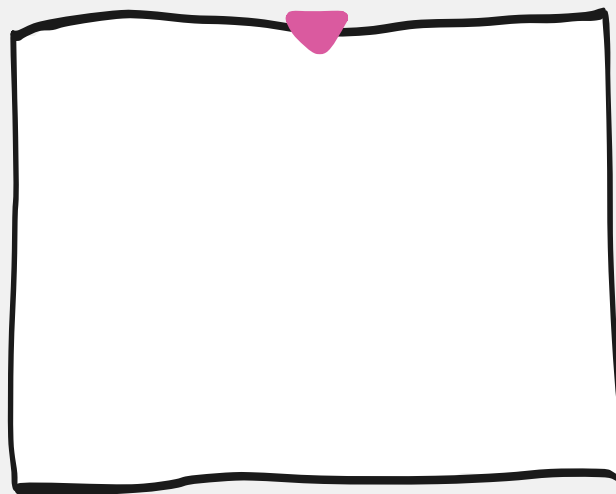
Sometimes 'Christians' call this stick 'God' and hit others with it.

🕒 Draw these 2 'commandment sticks' so that they intersect and see how they look together.



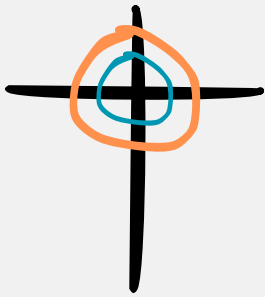
Suddenly, these 2 sticks become a cross.

? What does the cross mean to you?

By Jesus dying on the cross (and rising again - yay for that!), He beat death. He did this for us, so that we could be **re:united** for eternity.

So when you look at the very centre of the cross, you can see where the greatest 2 commandments meet - God's love for you specifically, and for everyone else in the world.

It's like looking through the scope on a camera to line up the perfect shot. God has **YOU** in centre focus.

To have our actions best **re**:flect what we believe - not what society wants or expects - we need to check-in with ourselves.

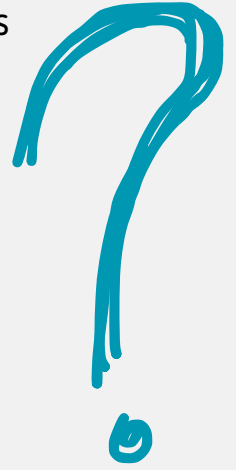
? How was it to check-in with yourself and make a plan to include God in your normal life routines?

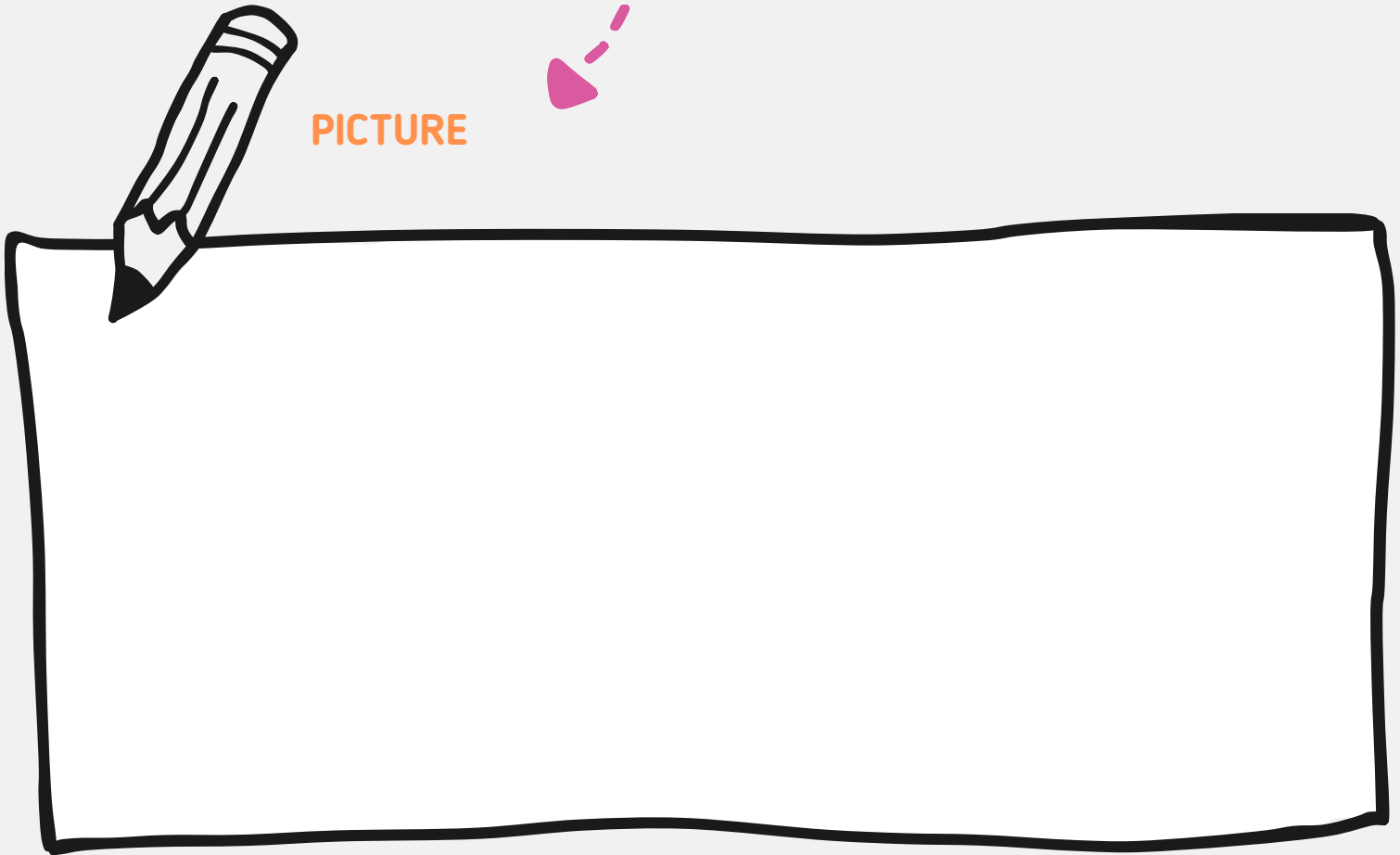

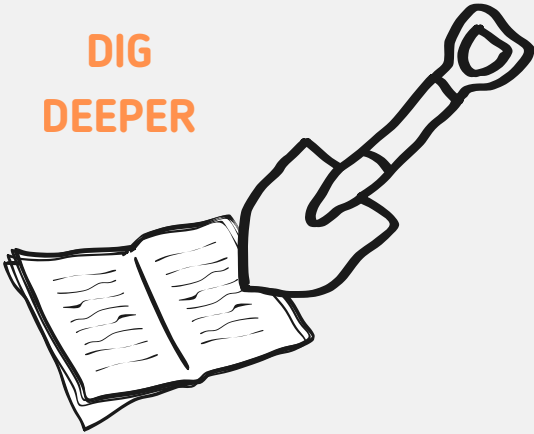
