A tug  
of war

Why do bad things happen?

Have you ever asked this question and what was your answer?

If God is most powerful, why can't He just stop the bad things from happening?

We are all in a tug of war between 2 powers who really want our loyalty. Maybe you can feel it. One moment you are enjoying something beautiful and great in life, and the next, you are let down, sad or anxious, and wonder why that 'thing' needed to happen. Better yet, who made that happen? Why didn't God stop it? And why didn't God just create a perfect world with no option for sin, right from the start?

All GREAT questions. But first, let's go back to the beginning.

There are many names for God, and in creation, the Hebrew name 'ēlōhîm (El-o-heem) is used. This is a plural name and it shows very clearly in Genesis 1:26a, as it says, 'Then **GOD** said, "Let **US** make mankind in **OUR** image..'

? What are your thoughts on this plurality of God?

God was in **community** right from the start, and created humans to be a part of it.

? Did God create robots? What makes you answer this way?

? What does free will mean?



I was walking in the snow with 2 friends and I picked some up and ate it. They asked if it tasted nice and I said, 'Yea it tastes a bit like raspberry!' (It didn't taste like raspberry. I was just being silly - but I did say it in a very believable way). One of them said, 'Really?! Can I try?'. I gave her some of my snow and she said, 'Yea it does!'. Of course, then the other friend wanted to try, and she said the same thing! At first, I thought they were just playing along with my joke, but I soon realised they were serious.

This is a great example of the power of suggestion.

? How does it work that they tasted raspberry simply because I re:commended it that way, and it wasn't even true?!

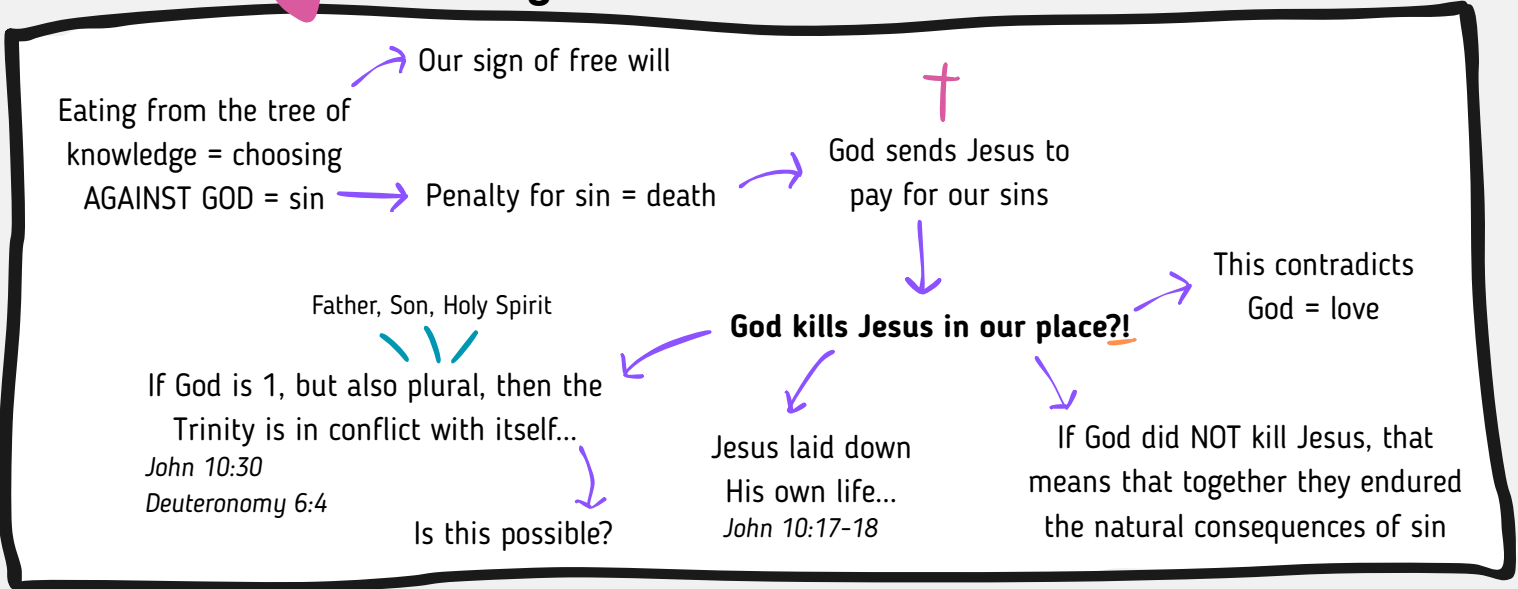

- ? Knowing that God did not create robot humans programmed to love Him only and not have a choice, what do you think about this risk God took, especially knowing that it would cost Him His own life?

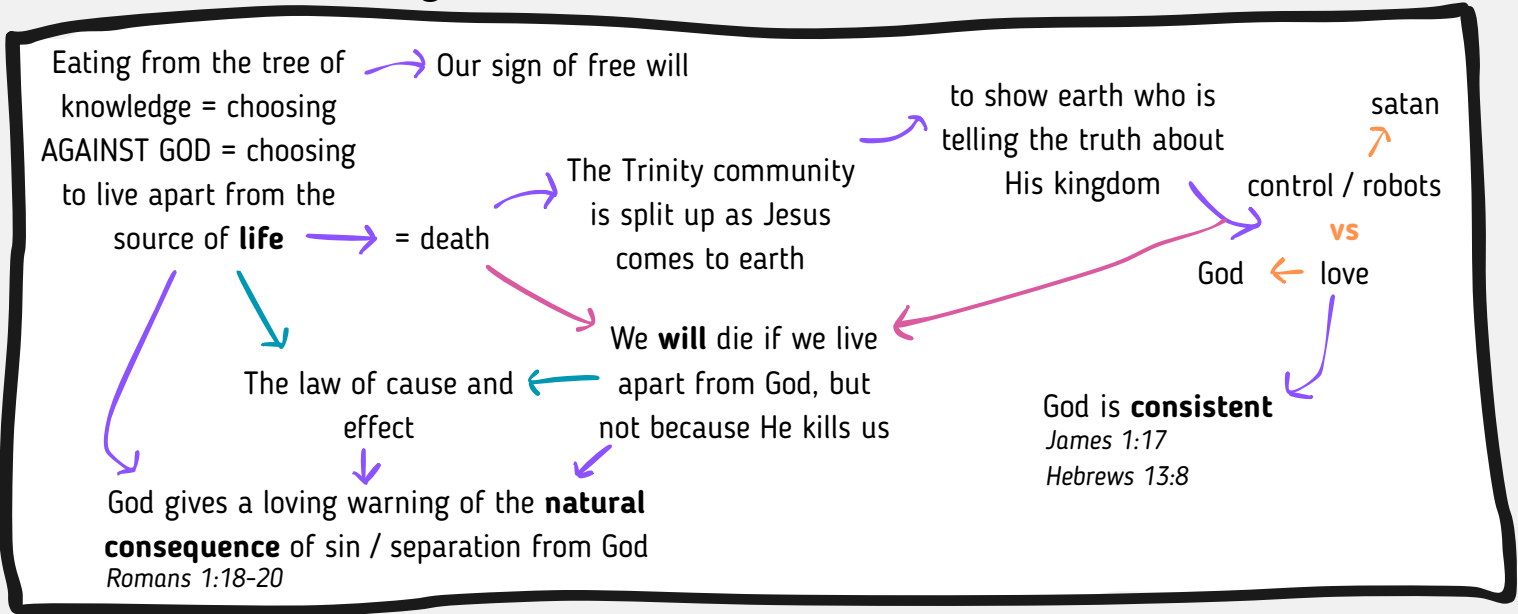
# MAPPING IT OUT

o Write some questions you have which you can write a mind map about.

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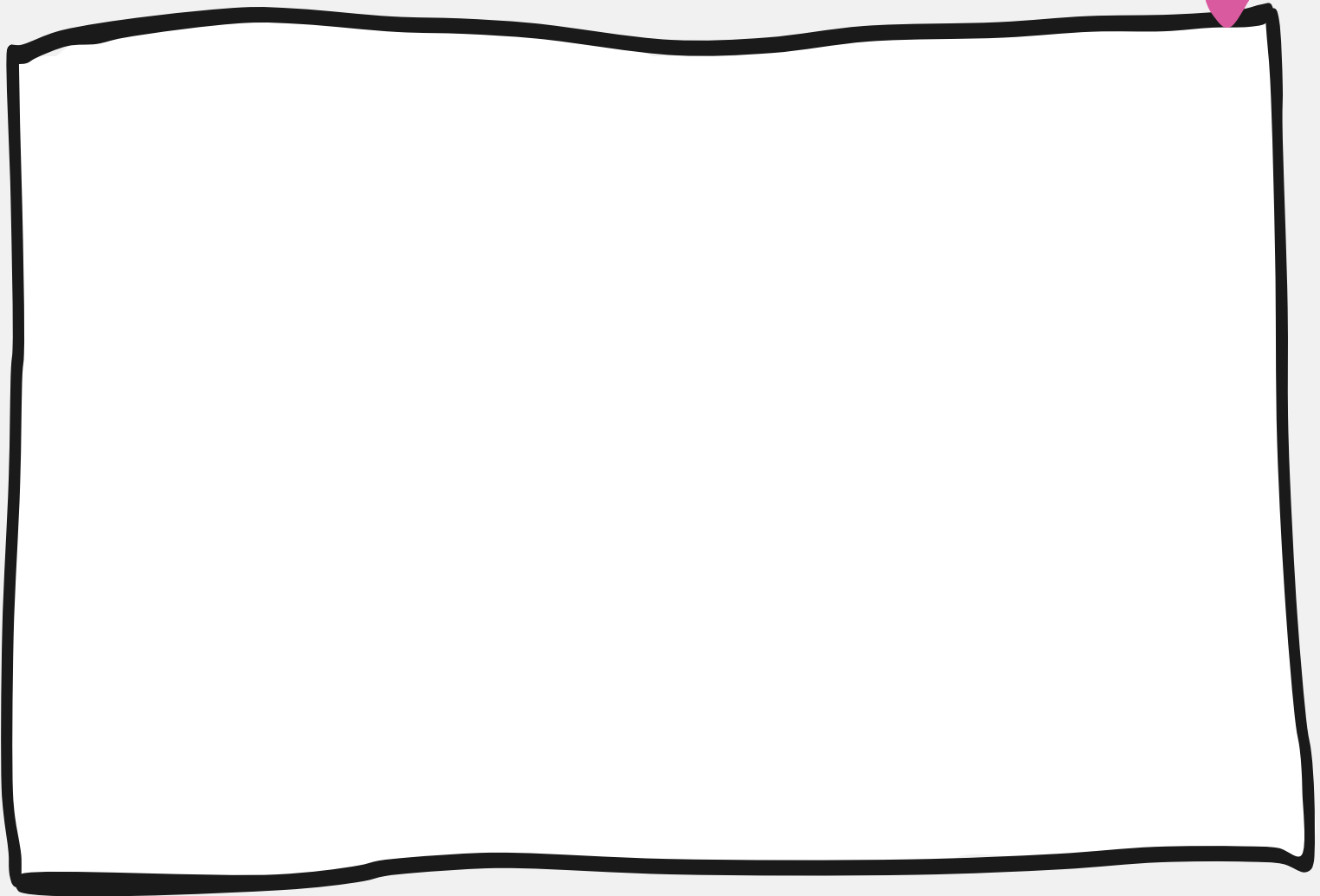


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- Draw a mind map to hash out some thoughts about the following question, or one you wrote above.

? What do you think would happen if God answered every single prayer that was prayed?

? What are your thoughts on the following statement?

*'Creating a world with free will was also a risk for God. He risked **re**jection, personal suffering and even sacrificing Himself for a creation who was hostile towards Him.'*

We stand in this conflict of wanting God to make everything all right when we snap our fingers and pray our wishes.

But that would mean we wouldn't have free will.

? How will you give God the power in this tug of war we are in, especially when you are going through a tough time and it is easy to blame God for not helping you as you want?

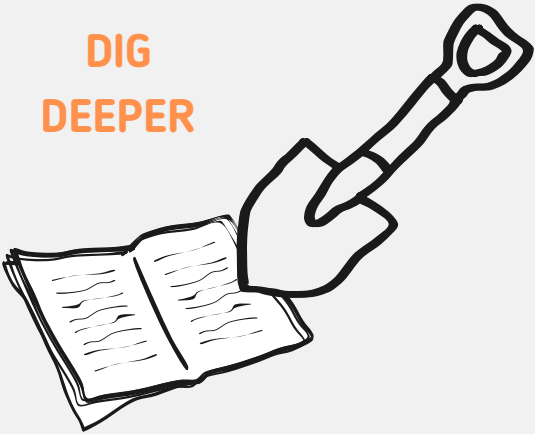
